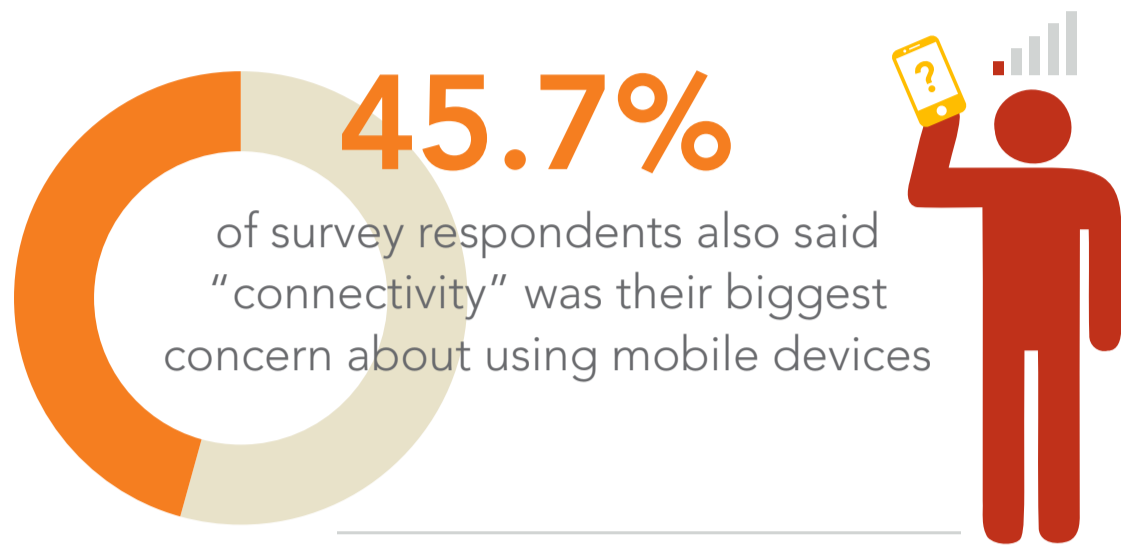


MOBILITY

WORK IS NO LONGER A LOCATION, IT'S AN ACTIVITY

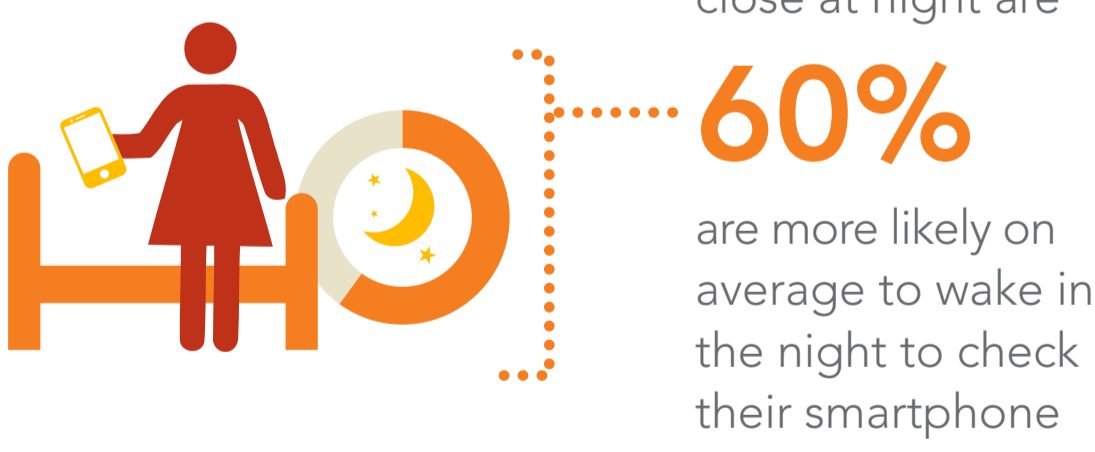
