despite changes to laws and policies across most western democracies intended to combat violence to women intimate partner violence and abuse ipva remains discouragingly commonplace domestic violence and psychology critical perspectives on intimate partner violence and abuse showcases women s harrowing stories of living with and leaving violent partners offering a psychological perspective on domestic violence and developing a theoretical framework for examining the context intentions and experiences in the lives of people who experience abuse and abuse themselves nicolson provides an analysis of survivors real life stories and thoughts about ipva the attitudes of the general public and health and social care professionals are also presented and discussed the theoretical perspective employs three levels of evidence the material context discursive explanations and intrapsychic emotional domestic violence and psychology is divided into three parts accordingly engaging qualitative data from interviews and quantitative data from surveys to illustrate these theoretical perspectives although many pro feminist sociologists and activists firmly believe that any attempt to explain domestic violence potentially condones it this book takes up the challenge to make a compelling case demonstrating how we need to widen understanding of the psychology of survivors and their intimate relationships if we are to defeat ipva the new edition has been updated to include the latest developments in ipva research and practice and in particular examines the impact of a violent and abusive family life on all members including children this is essential reading for students academics and professionals interested in domestic abuse as well as professionals and practitioners including psychologists social workers the police prison officers probation staff policy makers and charity workers

a handbook on domestic violence victim survival techniques domestic violence is a crime domestic violence is about power and control over another person it is not a problem with anger rarely do you see an abuser act violently with friends coworkers or a boss it is a jeckyl and hyde personality that confuses others who learn of a person s violence with their partners abusers can act charming loving and attentive when they want to drinking drugs genetics the victim s behavior or stress does not cause domestic violence it is learned behavior it is learned in the home by observation and reinforcement before the age of 10 domestic violence happens in all races religions and socio economic groups a relationship starts in the honeymoon phase over time tension starts building usually when the abuser feels that the victim is sufficiently hooked into the relationship either through marriage moving in together or getting pregnant the abuse starts the honeymoon phase is what hooks the victim back into the relationship and keeps the cycle moving over time the cycle reduces to just tension abuse and the episodes of violence get more frequent and severe victims often leave their abusers an average of five to seven times before they are able to leave permanently the victim is in greater danger when they decide to leave only the victim can decide what is best for them and their children it is important to recognize that they are the experts in their relationship not an outsider never tell a victim just leave him her the victim must develop a safety plan they will know when it will be the best time to leave summary domestic violence also domestic abuse spousal abuse battering family violence and intimate partner violence is a pattern of behavior which involves violence or other

abuse by one person against another in a domestic context such as in marriage or cohabitation intimate partner violence is domestic violence against a spouse or other intimate partner domestic violence can take place in heterosexual or same sex relationships domestic violence can take a number of forms including physical emotional verbal economic and sexual abuse which can range from subtle coercive forms to marital rape and to violent physical abuse that results in disfigurement or death globally a wife or female partner is more commonly the victim of domestic violence though the victim can also be the male partner or both partners may engage in abusive or violent behavior or the victim may act in self defense or retaliation domestic violence often occurs because the perpetrator believes that abuse is justified and acceptable and may produce intergenerational cycles of abuse that condone violence awareness perception definition and documentation of domestic violence differs widely from country to country there may be a cycle of abuse during which tensions rise and an act of violence is committed followed by a period of reconciliation and calm victims of domestic violence may be trapped in domestic violent situations through isolation power and control insufficient financial resources fear shame or to protect children as a result of abuse victims may experience physical disabilities chronic health problems mental illness limited finances and poor ability to create healthy relationships victims may experience post traumatic stress disorder children who live in a household with violence show dysregulated aggression from an early age that may later contribute to continuing the legacy of abuse when they reach adulthood domestic violence often happens in the context of forced and child marriage 2

domestic violence is a serious social problem that is heart breaking to each and every victim who experiences the abuse however it has hitherto been depicted in a misleading manner by portraying men as always the perpetrators and women always the victims this book is packed with factual evidence that shows that men are also victims of domestic violence perpetrated by their wives or female partners and in high numbers it thus dispels this old misleading stereotype and establishes that domestic violence is not a gender issue as heretofore portrayed but a social issue and one capable of being perpetrated by either partner in an intimate relationship truth and prejudice mens experiences of domestic violence is based on a review of research findings from around the world covering australia canada china south africa uganda united kingdom and united states confirming the reality of domestic violence against men by their wives or female partners the book unveils the truth head on and lays bare the prejudice that male victims are subjected to by those responsible for responding to domestic violence victims divided into four chapters each examining a key issue of mens experiences the subjects under discussion are the prevalence and extent of this abuse against
